





Criteria for Sampling Sets

Same Builder



Same Brewery



Sampler Pack

Same Construction Type

Same Envelope System Not good to mix types of alcohol

"Liquor before Beer..."

Your heads not clear



WC (Worst Case) Projected Rating for each unit Type

Acts as your checklist w/ minimum thresholds

+ 100% QA of all WC files

Sampler Pack

VISUAL	Clear, amber and bright with white lacing
AROMA	Sweet biscuty and caramel malts, subtle notes of fresh fennel and green apple
FLAVOR	Toasty malt, gentle sweetness, flash of fresh hop bitterness. The malt and hops are perfectly balanced.
MOUTHFEEL	carbonation and light sweetness finish clean on your palate.
BODY	Medium

IBU	22
YEAST	House Ale Yeast



Sampler Pack

"Controls"

 Minimum rated feature to be sampled



• Can pull a feature out to be inspected 100%

Brewery may choose to only sample alcohol content or IBU

Must Pass 7 in a Row



Sampler Pack

Each home counts as a rating and gets a registry ID





Sample Sets — Sampler Pack

3 Levels of Failures

- 1. Initial Failure
- 2. Additional Failure
- 3. Multiple Additional Failures



Sampler Pack

"Initial failure"-

Must (get to) inspect failed control for 2 more in batch

Failure must be corrected before sampling can resume





Sampler Pack

"Additional failure"-

More than 1 failure in set

Must (get to) inspect failed control(s) in all homes in that batch

All Failures must be corrected before sampling can resume





"Multiple Additional failures"

• 3 sets have more than 1 failure in 90 days Sampler Pack





Sampler Pack

3 "Additional Failures" in 90 days

If additional failure is <u>same</u> control throughout all 3 sets







• Must inspect failed control and pass 7 in a row before can sample for that control again





Sampler Pack

3 "Additional Failures" in 90 days

If 3 sets of additional failures and not same control

- Must start over from beginning
- 7 full inspections in a row
